## Public Notice Of Consultation On The Witchford Modified Neighbourhood Development Plan - Regulation 16 – The Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 (As Amended)

During November 2024, Witchford Parish Council formally submitted its Neighbourhood Plan modification proposal (and supporting documents) to East Cambridgeshire District Council for independent examination, which includes a final round of public consultation. Witchford has an existing Neighbourhood Plan of 2020, which sets out a vision for the future of the parish and planning policies that will be used to determine planning applications locally (within the Witchford Neighbourhood Area). The modification proposal proposes to introduce five new policies under the theme of climate change. No current policies are propose to be deleted or amended.

In accordance with Regulation 16 of the Neighbourhood Planning Regulations 2012 (as amended), East Cambridgeshire District Council is inviting comments on the draft modification proposal and associated documents for the minimum required 6 weeks. The consultation period will be from **27 November 2024 to Tuesday 14 January 2025**.

The consultation is open to anyone to submit their representations.
