It was resolved: That the application from Mr Miguel Silveira to trade from a location defined as a Consent Street, to sell hot and cold food and drink from a mobile catering vehicle at 120 New Barns Avenue, Ely, be refused on the grounds that: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A significant effect on road safety would arise either from the siting of the trading activity itself, or from customers visiting or leaving the site; • There would be a significant loss of amenity caused by traffic, noise, rubbish, potential for the harbourage of vermin, odour or fumes; • The trading unit is not considered to be suitable in style or in keeping with the location requested.
