



Further to your information request FOI/EIR 25/26-029, please find your question and our response below.

Request:

I wish to make a freedom of information request for the following information:

- How many CCTV cameras does the Borough own and/or is the 'Data Controller' for?
- How many of these CCTV cameras are set to record video?
- How many times in the past 5 years has the Borough released recorded CCTV data to a member of the public in response to a Personal Data Access request/FOI request or similar request?
- How many times in the past 5 years has the Borough released recorded CCTV data in response to a request from the courts or legal representative?
- When releasing CCTV video, is it Borough policy to redact or blur out the faces of uninvolved members of the public who may have been incidentally captured on the video being released?
- If so, is this video redaction ('blurring out') task carried out by Borough staff in-house or performed by an outside agency/service provider?

Response:

East Cambridgeshire District Council owns and operates CCTC on Council buildings and in Council owned car parks only. Town centre CCTV falls under the remit of Ely City Council.
