



Further to your information request FOI/EIR 25/26-056, please find your question and our response below.

**Request:**

Each individual member of my household has today received a leaflet, in separate envelopes.

At the very least you could have just posted one leaflet per household and not outsourced the delivery to Royal Mail. How much did this cost??

I don't often raise such concerns, but this just struck me as being utterly tone-deaf in the current economic climate.

**Response:**

In accordance with current legislation, all eligible electors must receive their own copy of the mayoral booklet. It is the responsibility of the Combined Authority Returning Officer to provide the booklets on behalf of the Combined Authority.

The estimated cost of delivering the booklets to every eligible elector in the Cambridgeshire and Peterborough electoral area, totalling c645,000 electors, is £518,602.
