Request:

I and my wife have today received by post a booklet about the election of the mayor for Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Authority if this is paid for by the hard pressed rate payers I hope someone can explain to me why you can't find money for that but not able to sort out the broken roads in this county.

Response:

In accordance with current legislation, all eligible electors must receive their own copy of the mayoral booklet. It is the responsibility of the Combined Authority Returning Officer to provide the booklets on behalf of the Combined Authority.

The responsibility for roads rests with Cambridgeshire County Council.
