I am making a request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 on 23.07.2025 for The Sunday Times newspaper for the following information

- Has the local authority adopted the Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) and, if so, when did it adopt this tax?
- How much money received via CIL payments is currently held, unspent, by the local planning authority?
- How much of this sum has been allocated for infrastructure projects and how much is currently unallocated?
- What is the current interest rate (%) that the local authority receives for holding unspent CIL money?
- What was the monetary value of the interest accrued from unspent CIL monies for the financial year 2023/24?
- Are CIL funds ring-fenced for community infrastructure projects?
- Is the interest generated from unspent CIL monies directed towards the local authority's general fund?
- What is the rate (£ per square metre) that the local authority charges for CIL-liable development?
- How many planning applications for main residences were liable for CIL in 2023/24?
- What percentage of property developments with 10 or more residential dwellings were liable for CIL in 2023/24?
