Further to your information request FOI/EIR 23/24-222, please find your question and our response below.

Request:

Please could you provide figures for the number of reports, fixed penalty notices (FPNs), prosecutions and fines relating to dog fouling from August 2013 - August 2023 for East Cambridgeshire? If available, please could you also provide a breakdown of where these reports, fixed penalty notices (FPNs), prosecutions and fines relating to dog fouling have occurred (for example: parks, beaches, private property etc)?

Response:

Between 1st April 2013 to 31st August 2023 the council received 90 reports of dog fouling.

6 FPN's have been served in this period. No prosecutions or fines in this period.

I cannot provide a breakdown of the type of area each one of the 90 reports of dog fouling relate to, but can advise that of the 6 FPN's served 2 were in relation to dog fouling on the pavement, 1 on an area of public grass next to a road, 1 was on a lawn to the front of a private property and 2 were on recreation/playing fields.
