

Further to your information request FOI/EIR 23/24-362, please find your question and our response below.

Request:

Please tell me what plans there are in 2024 for the two mazes in Pocket Park, also known as Ely Country Park.

Response:

The plan for the maze in 2024, another possible herbicide treatment before putting the whole area down to grass, by sowing in the spring. We will then programme regular mowing, throughout the rest of the year. The purpose of this is to get the nettles and other perennial weeds under control. Later in the year we will then reestablish the lay out of the maze, we will then decide if the soil is clean enough to replant.
