Further to your information request FOI/EIR 23/24-369, please find your question and our response below.

Request:

- 1. Please could you tell me whether there are any asylum seekers being accommodated in hotels in your local authority area? i.e. Is the council giving money to hotel/B&B/inn/(any type of business you can reasonably assume is in a similar category) owners to house asylum seekers or illegal immigrants. To be clear, I am not asking you to provide any information that would directly identify or reveal the specific address or ward area in which asylum seekers are being housed. I would only like to know whether your local authority area is currently accommodating asylum seekers in a hotel or hotels, or not.
- 2. Please could you tell me whether there are any asylum seekers being accommodated in privately rented accommodation in your local authority area? i.e. Is the council giving money to private landlords to house asylum seekers or illegal immigrants. To be clear, I am not asking you to provide any information that would directly identify or reveal the specific address or ward area in which asylum seekers are being housed. I would only like to know whether your local authority area is currently accommodating asylum seekers in a hotel or hotels, or not.
