2. Whilst the premises was generally very clean, the floor beneath the racking in parts of the warehouse was not clean. You must thoroughly clean the floor beneath the racking and maintain it in a clean condition.

Regulation (EC) No 852/2004 Annex II Chapter 1 Para 1 Mr. Cutmore confirmed that the relevant flooring would be cleaned on 27/04/2022


3. The premises was generally in very good repair and the construction sound, however, there was a gap in the strip at the base of the warehouse shutter large enough to permit pest entry. You must seal the gap to prevent pest entry.

Regulation (EC) No 852/2004 Annex II Chapter 1 Para 2 (c) Arrangements were already in place to repair the strip before I left the premises.
